Recently, I have served as a design consultant for private clients – including a restaurant in need of a period style specialist. I also build or create custom pieces for private clients, and renovate my post war cottage in my spare time.


I consider myself a teaching artist, and I have held a variety of educational positions. My full CV includes all positions held and courses taught.

The Army ROTC commissioned a dragon as a mascot. Over the course of a semester, I guided a student in an Independent Study in Properties Construction to create the Army Dragon.




Original Design Rendering


